The main purpose of the conference is to coordinate internal Russian and international virological research related to the study of viral pathogens that are potentially dangerous to humans, animals and agricultural crops. The traditional sections the "Climate Trends and Regional Virology Issues For Biodiversity", the "Ecology Of Viruses Carried By Migratory Animals", the "Hot Spots in Virology" section, the "Modern Approaches and Data Analysis" section, and the "Plant and Animal Viruses" sections will remain. We also invite veterinarians and physicians to contribute to the range of virological topics discussed.

The School program includes trips to the habitats of bats in the Novosibirsk Region, collection of biological material, and ornithological and chiropterological workshops.

MATERIALS FOR ABSTRACT-BOOK:

Abstracts can be submitted in **two languages**: English and Russian. The volume of abstract can be no more than 1 page in Russian and no more than 1 page in English. Electronic File Name: section number_ last name of the first author _ abstract (e.g.: 3_ ivanov_abstract).

The font Times New Roman, size - 10, spacing - 1.15; alignment in width, paragraph indent - 1.0 cm, sheet size – A5, orientation – portrait, margins - 1.27 cm. Abstracts are published in the author's version.

HEADER DESIGN:

- **TITLE OF THE REPORT** - in capital letters, bold type, centre alignment;
- ***Full name of the author/authors*** – bold italic font, centre alignment;
- *Organization, place of work of the author/authors, city, country* – italic font, centre alignment;
- *e-mail*

FORMATTING THE TEXT:

- **UDC**
- **Keywords** – no more than 6 keywords reflecting the main research problems and contributing to the indexing of the article in search engines
- Text – theses of report, font Times New Roman, size - 10, spacing - 1.15; alignment in width, paragraph indent - 1.0 cm.
